



**Summary of Parents' Circular No. P036/15**

17 September, 2015

Dear Parents,

**1. Drinking Water Lead Test Report**

- 1.1. In the midst of the excessive lead content found in the water supply of several housing estates and school premises, our school conducted water lead test during the summer vacation. **The result is that the 10 water samples meet the World Health Organization (WHO) Guidelines for Drinking-water Quality for lead content criteria.**
- 1.2. Moreover, our catering services supplier, Murray Catering Co Ltd, has also conducted water lead test on their water supply. **The result shows that the water samples also meet the WHO standard.**
- 1.3. The school has installed a water purifying system for all water dispensers. We also monitor and change the filter cartridges regularly for the health of our students.

**2. Arrangement for Chinese and English Dictation as Formative Assessment**

2.1. The arrangement for both Chinese and English Dictation. Details are as follows:

## **5. Primary One Admission (POA) for September 2016**

- 5.1. To be eligible for participation in POA System, the child must:
- (A) reach the age of 5 years 8 months (i.e. born on or before 31 December 2010);
  - (B) be a Hong Kong citizen;
  - (C) is not attending any primary schools; and
  - (D) have never been allocated a P.1 place.
- 5.2. Any eligible children who intend to study P.1 in our school in September 2016 should **submit the completed “Application Form for Admission to Primary One” to the school office at Room 101 on 1st floor from Monday, 21 September to Friday, 25 September 2015.**
- 5.3. Application forms can be obtained from the kindergarten the child is attending, District Offices (Public Enquiry Service Centres), the School Places Allocation Section or the Regional Education Offices of the Education Bureau.

## **6. Interest Groups (Phase 1)**

- 6.1. Students are encouraged to participate in various activities that are mainly conducted on Saturdays or after school on weekdays.
- 6.2. The following interest groups are open for enrolment this year:

- 6.4. Students will be chosen by lot in case of over-enrolment. In case of under-enrolment, fees will be returned. **Students will be noticed the results of enrollment on or before Monday, 5 October. “Confirmation Notice” will be received prior to the commencement of the class as well.**
