### **3. Immunisation for P1 & P6 Students**

- 3.1. The School Immunisation Team from the Department of Health will visit our school on **Monday, 14 December** offer Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccines to eligible P1 & P6 students. P6 students will also receive vaccine for Hepatitis B.
- 3.2. Since the students will also receive other vaccines in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Term, **all** the immunisation records (**original copy**) of your child will be collected. They will be kept by school until next vaccination in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Term. If you need them back, please contact the class teacher.
- 3.3. **Please complete the reply slip and return the relevant documents to the class teacher by Friday 16 October.**

### **4. Free Lunch at Schools guidelines**

- 4.1. Primary 1 to Primary 6 students receiving full grant under the Student Financial Assistance Schemes (SFAS) are eligible to participate in the Free Lunch at Schools.
- 4.2. Parents have to submit to the school the Notification of Result for Assessment of Eligibility or Eligibility Certificate issued by the Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFAA) as a proof of their children's SFAS full grant status and their consent to have lunch arranged by the school.
- 4.3. The subsidy of the Free Lunch at Schools should be available as from the date on which the application is submitted by parents.
  - (i) For parents who have submitted the application for Free Lunch at Schools at the beginning of the school year and have provided all the documentary proof required, the lunch subsidy should be available from September;
  - (ii) For parents who are waiting for the assessment result of the SFAS when submitting the application for Free Lunch at Schools, and have already made the payment for the lunch expenses for their children, if they can produce the documentary proof as required afterwards, the lunch subsidy should be available from the date on which they submit their applications for Free Lunch at Schools;
  - (iii) If parents do not intend to apply for Free Lunch at Schools at the beginning of the school year, they can submit their applications to schools later. However, the lunch subsidy will only be available from the date on which the application for Free Lunch at Schools is submitted to the school by parents. There should be no retrospective effect on lunch subsidy before the date of application.
